SUMMARY EXPLANATION:

Staff is requesting approval to exceed the approved Budget amount of \$60,000.00 by \$5,000.00 to purchase a NEW Compost Screener in place of the proposed used compost screener originally approved in the 2018 Budget for the Solid Waste Recycling yard. The original budget item was based on research conducted by staff which determined the market for used screeners was approximately \$60,000.00. Since then and very recently staff was able to secure a new (demo) compost screener. This screener would come with training and a warranty. The excess funds would come from Capital Reserve funds, which The Director of Finance has confirmed to be available.
