The Germantown Police Department Explorer Post is a group of young men and women ages 14 - 20 who have an interest in learning about law enforcement as a possible career. Explorers learn about the law, court procedures, police patrol techniques and organizational skills. Upon meeting requirements, Explorers are allowed to ride along with a patrol officer and respond to police calls, participate in the normal routines of Community Policing and interacting with the community. Explorers get a first hand perspective of the realities of modern day law enforcement.

The Explorer program is designed to build character, develop leadership skills and personal potential, develop an appreciation of community service and good citizenship habits. Explorers take in such events as: Citizen Police Academies, crowd and traffic control at the 4th of July parade and fireworks, the Christmas parade, the Police Department Open House and other community and special events.

If you are age 14-20 with no major Criminal record, not on probation, maintain at least a 2.5 GPA, are able to attend monthly meetings and serve a minimum of 16 hours of Community Service with the Post each year - we would like to meet you!
